When it comes to almsgiving, I would like you to put this in the context of stewardship. Give of your time, talent and treasure. Depending on what and how you do, you can be doing both corporal and spiritual works of Mercy. In this way you would be ministering to your fellow pilgrims.

As we do this, we will hear God saying to us: Here I am! This will be an assurance to us that we are not alone. God is our travelling Companion! Even now we will begin to experience that burning in our hearts as we travel along.


